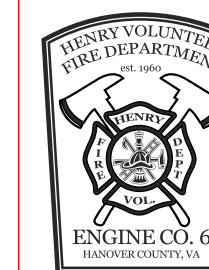

History of the Fire Department Speaking Trumpet or Bugle

When American volunteer fire fighting companies began to form during the late 18th century, a need emerged for organized efforts and better communication in combating conflagrations. Officers would use "speaking trumpets" or "bugles" to amplify their voices over the noise and commotion of a fire scene to direct the company to effectively fight the blaze. Often times, officers called cadence through the trumpets to keep the men on the hand pumpers in time. The trumpet or bugle was worn around the officer's neck so they could be easily identified as they directed fire fighting operations. The trumpet or bugle around the officer's neck lead to the designation of an officer in the fire department, and has been carried on to this day as an insignia of rank worn on the uniform collar.
